

FAQs - UNSW Research Integrity Training for HDRs

How do I access the research integrity training?

- Accessing the online Moodle course is easy. Instructions including a link are sent to your UNSW email account following your enrolment into the training. Once enrolled, log into Moodle with your zID and zPass and access the online training at <https://moodle.telt.unsw.edu.au/course/view.php?id=55558>

Why is it important to complete?

- Successful completion of the training is required in order to achieve a **satisfactory outcome at your first Research Progress Review**. It provides you with insights and knowledge that are needed to conduct research both now and throughout your academic career. It encapsulates and supports UNSW's commitment to creating and maintaining an environment that promotes responsible research conduct in an international context.

How long will the training take to complete?

- Completing the training may take you up to **4 hours**. You do not have to complete it all in one go.

When do I need to complete the training by?

- Finishing the training including each of the 8 short quizzes that accompany each of the 8 modules, is expected by **Monday 30 November 2020 at 4pm (AEST)**, after which you will no longer have access to the Moodle course.

What is required for successful completion of the training?

- Achieving a minimum of **75% per quiz** for the quiz component of the package (you must answer at least 3 out of 4 questions correctly in each quiz that accompanies each of the 8 modules).
- There is a **maximum of three attempts per quiz. Following an unsuccessful attempt, you will be unable to reattempt the quiz for 48 hours**. You are encouraged to discuss the unsuccessful module content with your supervisor or PGC before re-attempting the module quiz.

How will successful completion be recognised?

- Completing this online training successfully will be recorded on your Australian Higher Education Graduation Statement (AHEGS).
