

Enrolment instructions for UNSW Supervising Doctoral Studies, *Epigeum* online resource

To make it easier for you to find this course on Moodle the following 4 steps will work best.

1. Moodle sign in: <https://moodle.telt.unsw.edu.au/login/index.php>
2. Once logged in, select the “*Site Home*” tab in the far top right hand corner of Moodle (not easy to find)



3. You will then be taken to the Search courses window. Type in *UNSW Supervising Doctoral Studies* in this window and press “Go”



4. Copy and paste the following **self enrolment key**: *SupervisorDev01* into the self enrolment (Participant) box and then click on “Enrol Me”
