
How to Access the Training (Log-in Instructions) -Two Methods

Method 1. If you haven't signed into Moodle (Web Single Sign On)


- Click on the course link: https://moodle.telt.unsw.edu.au/course/view.php?id=36814






Completing the Check-in Quiz first will help you identify areas of focus and assist you in completing the required Final Assessment more quickly and efficiently.

- 5. Click "submit" once you finish.






Selecting your Discipline Package


