## NAVIGATING iRECS

### **Duplicating an application/project**

Notes:

- Project Owners (Applicants) are able to duplicate the content of an existing project into a new application. This
  function is useful if you have multiple projects with similar content, or if you need to replace an expired
  application.
- All form content will be duplicated into the new project <u>except for any attached documents</u> which will need to be uploaded manually.
- Do not duplicate a form to submit a modification, you should submit a modification request instead.

### Steps:

- 1. In your Work Area click Duplicate Project.
- Select the project you wish to duplicate. Enter the new project title. <u>Do not select 'including sub-forms'</u>, as doing so would duplicate all the protocol deviations and compliance reports across to the new (duplicated) project.
- 3. Click Duplicate.

4. Edit and submit the new application – ensure that all information duplicated is relevant to the new application. Do not upload legacy files or previously approved modifications – if these are still relevant, the content should be added into the form questions so that your new application can be reviewed as a standalone application.
